## Case Study – May 2018 - Landmarc Ltd on behalf of Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO), part of the MoD





**Background:** DIO is part of the MoD which is responsible for acquisition, disposal, allocation of assets, construction and maintenance of estate infrastructure in the UK and abroad.

**Origins:** Following a long tender process with Landmarc we won the contract to refurbish "C" Range at Bulford Firing Ranges to bring them up to modern compliance specification. We had previously undertaken work for Landmarc on firing ranges across Salisbury Plain.

**Requirement:** The project required the old tarmac and timber range floor to be removed and the firing trenches replaced with pre-fabricated concrete structures made off-site. We then fitted recycled plastic edging and then covered the whole site in a soft-pour surface.

**Approach:** We worked to a strict budget and timing restrictions while the range was closed for the works to be carried out. Neighbouring ranges were kept in use with live firing on a daily basis.

**Results:** We completed the project within the month, due to strict time constraints, and this is the first firing range on Salisbury Plain with this finish.

**Benefits:** Landmarc/DIO now have a safer range with no ricochet hazard; one that is maintenance free and hard wearing.
